## What's on



**Donkey Common** will have a mix of food and drink, market and craft stalls. A fire engine will be parked alongside, on **Mortimer Road**, so you can have a close look and talk to the crew.

**Petersfield Green** will also have food and drink, market and craft stalls, plus the mysterious, meditative labyrinth. At Covent Garden, there will be a full day of film screenings in the **ARU Drama Centre**. There will be tours of **Mill Road Cemetery** at 11.30am and 2.00pm, and **Mill Road History Society** will also run a history tour at 8.45am the morning of the fair.

**Ditchburn Gardens** will have live music, craft stalls, hot food and mulled wine. Nearby, the **Cambridge Mosque** on Mawson Road will host activities, and the **Salvation Army Centre** on Tenison Road/

Mill Road will have an indoor children's venue, live music, refreshments, indoor stalls, and yoga upstairs.

The food fair will be based in the **Gwydir Street Car Park** and on **St Barnabas Road**. Nearby, there will be live music and children's activities at **St Barnabas Church**, and more children's activities to the rear in the **St Barnabas Centre**, as well as down the steps beside the bridge at **Railway House**. There will also be activities in the **Bath House**, and in the garden of the **David Parr House**.

Cambridge Community Circus will be at **Great Eastern Street** and, opposite, the **Argyle Street Housing Co-op** will host their usual live music and stalls. Cambridge 105 will broadcast live from outside the former **Tescos**.



The fair's HQ will be in the rear of **Mill Road Baptist Church**, with a quiet space in the church itself. **St Philip's Church** is planning a fabulous programme of indoor, family-friendly events and activities.

Back by popular demand, the Shake Your Tail Feather live music spot can be found on the corner of **Thoday Street**, and the **Salisbury Club** will be open for interactive activities arranged by Cambridge Hands-On Science.

Please continue to the warm welcome at **Romsey Mill**, where there will be a fabulous art show and festive activities for all the family. Look out too for the artists participating in Mill Road Open Studios in the streets nearby.

## Important information

Stewards wearing hi-vis jackets with Mill Road Winter Fair on the back are available to assist you. To help ensure your safety, please comply promptly with any instructions from stewards. If you see anything suspicious or unsafe, please report it to a steward immediately. In an emergency, follow instructions from stewards or the emergency services.

### First Aid

If you require First Aid, please ask the nearest steward or go to Event Control.

### Event Control

Event Control and First Aid are both located in the rear of the Baptist Church, 178 Mill Road, on the corner of Stockwell Street – see map overleaf.



### Missing children

Please arrange your own family meeting point in case you become separated. Report missing children to any steward or Event Control.

### Caution – vehicles!

Whilst Mill Road (between East Road and Coleridge Road), the top of Gwydir Street, the top of St Barnabas Road and the entrance to Ironworks will be closed to most traffic (including all cyclists) between 9.00am and 5.30pm on the day, there will be some vehicle movement. Pedestrians should exercise particular care before the road is fully closed. Re-opening will occur gradually, so drivers



and pedestrians should take extreme care. Pedestrians will be required to make way for emergency and other vehicles within the closure area, from time to time. There is no access to the road closure without permission. Permitted vehicles must drive at walking pace, exercise extreme care for pedestrians, and follow any steward instructions. Mill Road is a residential street. Please respect residents and do not trespass in private gardens.
